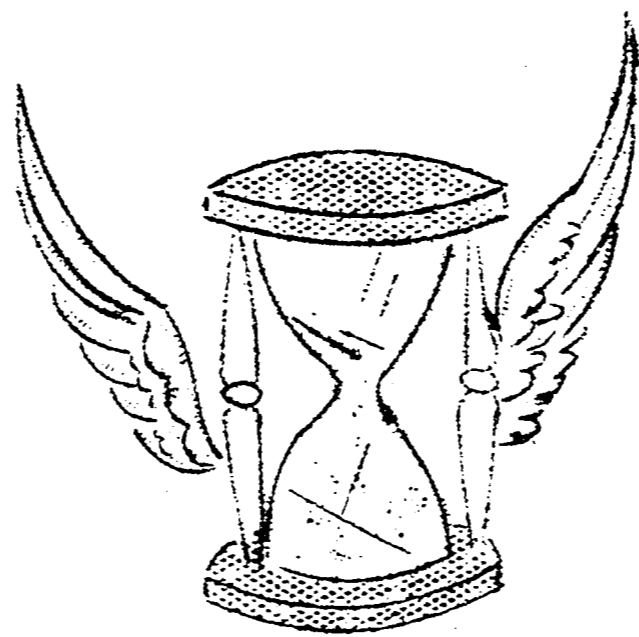

ORIGIN OF THE NAME  
"HINGHAUS"  
AND A BRIEF FAMILY HISTORY

There were two distinct branches of the Hinkhouse, or Hinghaus, family originally--the dark, Catholic Bavarians; and the blond, Protestant Hanoverians. The families listed in this genealogy belong to the latter. Their ancestors emigrated from Bavaria because of their Protestant religion about the time of the Reformation, and disguised themselves as Nordics.

THE NAME

The original name was Smith or Schmidt, as family names in those days were chosen from the occupation followed. The change of the name to "Hinghaus"--literally, one who hangs houses, or a free translation of carpenter, one who works in wood--came about as follows. A warrior member of the family, by act of bravery or strategy, repulsed a mighty enemy, and as a reward for this, was made a baron and given a large tract of land, which was a dense forest. His family began clearing and building--"hanging" houses--thereby giving up his original occupation as a smith, or metal worker. Hence, "Hinghaus."

Some names are quite common. But occasionally a name is so unusual that it is natural to assume all people of the name living today are related. So it is with the name "Hinkhouse," which is a rare one. Wide research has failed to find it outside the family concerned in this genealogy. This family connection is now quite extensive. Many who trace their origin back to the ancestral home in Germany use <sup>the</sup> slightly different spelling, "Hinghaus." This is particularly true of those who live in Germany, although there are a few families living in America who also use this spelling. There is also a family located in Texas, probably descendants of the Bavarian branch, that spells the name with an e instead of an i--Henkhaus. (Incidentally, there is a town in the State of Texas by the name of Henkhaus, Texas.)

The name has had various spellings by our early progenitors--Hedink, Hyngs, Hyings, Hyinghaus, Hinghaus. Frederick and Henry Hinghaus, two brothers, were the first to leave Germany, and come to the United States of America (in the early 1840's). Fred settled in York County, Pennsylvania, for a while before moving to Iowa about 1853. When he took out his naturalization papers, he used the spelling "Hinkhouse," for so the people among whom he lived in Pennsylvania called him.

Perhaps this spelling was not the happiest and most fitting choice. One of the oldest living Hinkhouses recently made this observation concerning the change in the spelling of the name from Hinghaus to Hinkhouse: "The spelling 'Hinkhouse' is English, and to me is about as far from being euphonious as any name I have ever heard. I never can pronounce it to a stranger so he can pronounce it without spelling it out for him. The two consonants k and h coming together make it difficult to pronounce and understand. Had I been trying to Anglicize the original name 'Hinghaus,' I should have made it 'Hingus,' and thus much more pronounceable than it is now."

Origin, Name, and Brief History--2

THE FAMILY

From a photostatic reproduction of our ancestral outline, made by the pastor of the old family church in Germany at the time Frank Leimkuehler visited there in 1887, we are able to trace our lineage as far back as 1727, or to Johann Heinrich Hying (Hedink). Tracing through, we find that our forebear, Johann Fridrich Hyinghaus, was married to Anna Maria Charlotte Krampen in 1817, and had ten children--eight boys and two girls.

It is with these ten children that we are particularly concerned, and in one of these ten, the various descendants who read this genealogy will doubtless recognize their paternal or maternal ancestors. We are not positive regarding the exact order in which the ten should be listed, but as near as we can determine, they should be listed in this order:

I. Frederick II. Francis III. Laceta IV. Henry V. Bernhardt VI. Wilhelm VII. Adam VIII. Wilhelmina IX. Rudolph X. Herman.

It is from these ten that we are all descended. They will be listed in Roman numerals throughout the genealogy proper which follows. All of the ten children were born in Germany. All except one son, Wilhelm, and the two daughters came to America in the course of time, and died in the land of their adoption.

BRIEF CHARACTERIZATION OF THE TEN CHILDREN

One of the oldest living Hinkhouses, who knew well all of the brothers who came to America, and who has a keen insight into human nature, has given us a brief and interesting characterization of them, to which we have added slight bits of information coming from other sources. Here we have set forth some of their good qualities and some of their bad, some things we perhaps would not say of the living, but we hope it does no dishonor to the dead.

I. FREDERICK BERNARD HINKHOUSE, the eldest child, had a clear, keen intellect, with a quick temper, when aroused. A man of rare intellect, tireless energy, ceaseless industry, good business judgment, with an almost utter disregard for frivolous social customs and conventionalities, he was very sensitive and matter of fact, lacking a sense of humor. He had very little money when young, and as he grew older this seemed to prey upon his mind, and his main ambition seemed to be to make money, denying himself and his large family the comforts they could then well afford. So far as we know, Frederick has the largest family of the ten children, and two of his children also had large families. So he perhaps has the most living descendants of any of the ten today.

He was a school director where he lived in Iowa, and held other town offices, ever interested in the civic and intellectual welfare of the community. A member of the Presbyterian church. Fred came to America in the early 1840's. He and his brother Henry were the first to leave Germany. Born 1818, died 1885, buried in Sharon Cemetery, Cedar County, Iowa.

II. FRANZ or FRANCIS was as different from his brother Fred as two brothers could be. He was of jolly, humorous disposition, always joking and happy-go-lucky. A kindly gentleman, hale, hearty, and well-met, friendly with everyone, with a keen sense of humor. He cared nothing for worldly possessions, and was satisfied with a crust of bread to eat, and a pallet to sleep on, if he could have convivial companionship. Came to America in 1880. Born 1820, died 1892, buried at Sharon Cemetery, Cedar County, Iowa.

III. LACETA, one of the two girls, also called Elizabeth, married Herman Struck. Lived and died in Germany, and little is known of her or her family. Had seven sons, six of whom remained in Germany. The youngest, L. H. Struck, came to America and is now living in South Dakota.

IV. HENRY, the third son, was the handsomest of all, the dude of the family. He was tall, straight as an arrow, always well-dressed, and had a fine gift for language. Inclined to be arrogant, cynical, and critical. He and his brother Fred, were the first to come to America, landing at Baltimore, where he lived for many years, and was a bartender. Born in Bavaria in 1825, buried in Baltimore.

V. BERNHARDT was an intellectual giant. He could discourse on any subject, was a good linguist, a mathematician, and a philosopher. Mentally alert, but cared little for physical labor, and inclined to be quarrelsome. He was married twice and had a large family. Came to America about 1894, after his second marriage. Born 1827, died 1895, buried in Woodbury County, Iowa.

VI. WILHELM OR WILLIAM was the only son who did not come to America, and but little is known of him. Had a large family, and all but two of his children came to America. A hard worker. Buried in Germany.

VII. ADAM did not have robust health, and seemed to have difficulty getting a start in America. His brother Fred helped him some, until finally his health failed, and he died in middle age. Had a small family, and few descendants.

Died at Mt. Pleasant, Iowa, and was buried in Fred's lot in the Sharon Cemetery, Cedar County, Iowa. Came to America in 1859.

VIII. WILHELMINA also had a small family, and has few living descendants today. She married Fred Leimkuehler, and they both died in Germany. There were two boys and two girls, only one of which came to America--Frank. Frank Leimkuehler went back to the old homestead on a visit in 1887, and obtained valuable information on our ancestry while there.

IX. RUDOLPH was an even-balanced, all around good citizen, respected and admired by everyone, frugal and thrifty, accumulating a comfortable competency. He had only three children, all of whom are now deceased. Only one of the three was married, and she had no children, so there are no living descendants of this family. Came to America in 1859.

Born 1838, died 1899, buried at Muscatine, Iowa.

X. HERMAN, the youngest of the ten, born in Dissen, Province of Hanover, Germany, and came to America at about the age of seventeen, making his home for a time with his brother Fred in Cedar County, Iowa. At the outbreak of the Civil War, he enlisted in the Union Army, Sept. 16, 1861, being a member of the 11th Iowa infantry. About 1880 he moved to Kansas, and became a pioneer farmer in the wheat regions of the western part of the State. A bit gruff, he could swear like a trumper, but was big-hearted, independent, and provided well for his large family.

Came to America in 1859. Born 1841, died 1931, buried at Palco, Kansas.

DISTINGUISHED MEMBERS OF THE FAMILY

The late Rufus W. Hinkhouse. The story of his life was said to be essentially the story of the advancement of eastern Iowa. As a pioneer, with axe and plow, he aided in the transformation of prairie and forest into modern habitations and farms. A man of vigor, purpose, and generosity, active in the commercial and political life of the community, and at one time a member of the 26th General Assembly of Iowa.

The late Reverend John F. Hinkhouse, prominent Presbyterian preacher, lived a full life. For nearly fifty years he served as pastor in various Presbyterian churches in the State of Iowa. Especially interested in saving Iowa's rural churches because his early life had been spent on the farm. Slated Clerk in the Presbyteries of Corning, Council Bluffs, and Dubuque, Iowa. Elected Moderator of the Synod of Iowa in 1902, and its Slated Clerk in 1922. Also active in educational and editorial lines. Edited the letters of Charles W. McCleary, Presbyterian missionary to Africa, and also the experiences and explorations of the Tai Race, by W. C. Dodd, missionary to Siam. A short time before his death in 1933, he compiled and edited the 551-page book, "One Hundred Years of the Iowa Presbyterian Church."

Simon C. Hinkhouse, of Long Beach, California. A gentleman of the old school, for many years engaged in magazine and newspaper work. A writer whose articles on historical, psychological, social, and political subjects have received favorable comment both in Europe and America. Author of a historical brochure entitled, "Sugar Creek Township, Cedar County, Iowa." Has been called "The Bard of Sugar Creek." His poem, "A Retrospection," has been pronounced one of the finest delineations of character ever written. Gave invaluable help on the history of the family.

Dr. Myrtle Hinkhouse, granddaughter of Fred, has given long years of service in China. A versatile woman, an efficient physician, and a faithful Presbyterian missionary.

The late Leslie Whitmer, widely traveled son of Mary Hinkhouse-Whitmer, known from coast to coast, and from Canada to Mexico for his work, "Loan and Trust Companies."

(The two letters that follow tell of visits made by two American Hinkhouses to the old Hinghaus home in Germany, and reveal much of historic interest. As near as we can determine, there are two homesteads in Germany--one at Hilter, which belonged to Bernard Adam Hyinghaus, the eldest son of Gertrud Hyngs and Johann Adam Radenbrock; and the other at Dissen, four or five miles away, which belonged to the third son, Johann Fridrich Hyinghaus, our progenitor. The homestead referred to in the Paul Hinkhouse letter is evidently the Hilter homestead belonging to the eldest son. Both Hilter and Dissen are located in the province of Hanover, near Osnabruch, Germany.)

FRANK LEIMKUEHLER VISIT TO HINKHOUSE HOMESTEAD IN 1887

July 25, 1887  
Moscow, Iowa

Dear Cousin John:

I have been back some time, but as they keep me pretty busy I did not send you those papers which I brought along from Germany, and I thought you were in no hurry anyhow.

Now John I will give you a translation and explain it to you as near as I can. The first name on the paper is Johann Heinrich Schmedt, married to Clara Margaretha Maria Winekers, Nov. 13, 1727. This J. H. Schmedt bought the old Hinkhouse homestead which was spelled that time "Hedink." The house which was standing on the farm then is standing there yet, and occupied by your father's cousins. I was in it and looked all through it, and I saw the furniture which was from four to two hundred years old, name and date carved in the wood.

The above couple had three boys, and the younger one, Jost Heinrich, born Oct. 27, 1737, was heir to the homestead. He was married to Katharine Marie Niemeyer Feb. 6, 1761. This lady brought with her a cupboard made out of oak wood which is there yet and used by descendants. This couple had only one girl and became heir to the homestead. Her name was Marie Gertrud, and as the pastor at that time was a high German, he entered her name in the church book as Hyngs instead of Hedink. She was married to Johann Adam Radenbrock July 11, 1783, and this gentleman had his name changed to Hyngs, according to the custom of the country.

This couple had nine children--five boys and four girls. Heir to the homestead was that time, the oldest boy, Bernhard Adam, born Jan. 25, 1785. Our grandfather was the third son of the above couple and was born Sept. 19, 1794. He was baptized Bals Heinrich Fridrich Hyinghaus. The pastor at that time was, like a good many others, in favor of the French government and was ashamed to use the German tongue, so he entered Hyinghaus in the church book instead of Hyngs.

Bals Heinrich Fridrich married under the name of Johan Fridrich (this change or mistake was made by the pastor who was drunk at that time, and suspended shortly afterward) to Anna Maria Charlotte Krampen June 6, 1817. This couple moved right after their marriage to Borgloh and stayed there about eight years and moved then to Disson where they stayed to their end. The oldest son of this couple was your father [Frederick Bernard]. He was born Aug. 25, 1818, and baptized under the name of Freidrich Bernhard Hinghaus. The change of Hyinghaus to Hinghaus was made in 1811, by the pastor of that time who was a true German and hated all French spelling.

Well, John, this was all I could obtain as it is a very tiresome job. We had to look over all the books, as there is no index to refer to, and it took over six hours one day and three hours the next day to get what I got. All the families that married into the Hinkhouse family are still living there.

PAUL HINKHOUSE VISIT TO ANCESTRAL HOME IN GERMANY IN 1926

Aboard S.S. "Caledonia"  
September 20, 1926

Greetings All From Uretta and Paul:

Regarding our trip to Europe and visit to the ancestral Hinkhouse home at Hilter, Germany. We spent nearly three delightful weeks in Sweden, then on to Norway, Denmark, Germany, Holland, France, Belgium, and England.

Through Cousin Frank Leimkuehler, Mother secured the necessary information as to the whereabouts of the ancestral home, which hitherto had meant little or nothing to me. On our way from Germany to Holland, we stopped off at Osnabruck for the night and went to Hilter--about an hour's train ride--the next morning. We alighted at the station and asked the station master in broken German if he knew the whereabouts of the "Hinkhouse house." I told him I was an American, and that my grandfather had lived at Hilter. The house can be seen from the railroad station, and he pointed it out to us.

As we walked up the road and the house came in full view, my first thought was that we had been misinformed. I had given little thought to the social or financial condition of my ancestors, and had really expected to find a very humble dwelling. Imagine my surprise when I saw a very large, ivy-covered stone house, and a beautiful, flower-dotted, well laid-out front yard.

I said in German, to the first man I met, "I am an American, and my grandfather was a German whose name was Hinkhouse." He happened to be a laborer, and took me to a woman who in turn took me to her husband. The woman was the daughter of the present owner of the home--Meyer-Hinghaus. She was the only blood relative, aside from her children, that we saw. I wanted very much to talk at length with her, but she and a maid were busy getting dinner ready for the hands.

We were ushered into a well-furnished living room, made our explanations again, and finally Meyer-Hinghaus came in. I will not vouch for the accuracy of the information given to us in German, for it was hard to make ourselves understood and to understand. But I believe I am right in saying that the male line of the Hinkhouse family had either died out or left, that the name "Hinghaus" stays with the homestead, and that the man who married the eldest daughter resides there. In this case it was Mr. Meyer, with the given name of Fritz. Fritz was a pleasant, likable fellow, an officer on both the eastern and western fronts during the war (1914-1918). He said in French that it was very interesting to have us there.

Finally they brought out a frame containing pictures of grandfather and grandmother, and around them were placed all my uncles and aunts. Fritz said that I looked like "that one," which was Father. When we expressed a desire to go, he suggested that we see the place, and we were glad to do so. Adjoining the house, which was built recently, is an old stone barn. The barn is to the left in the post-card picture I am sending, and the house is to the right. This credit is found under the picture: "Meyer-Hinghaus Besitzung,

Hilter, Teutoburger Wald." And on the back of the postcard, this credit appears: "Karl Lubbert, Photographer, Atelier, Dissen, Teutoburger Wald."

I noticed a couple of shotguns hanging near the coatrack, and asked Fritz what game was in the vicinity. He said rabbits, and invited me to come back sometime and go hunting with him in the forest. I do not know how large the farm is, but there is a large forest on it, which gives the home the name of Teutoburger Wald. Adjoining the barn is a part of the original home, dating back to the seventeenth century, if memory serves me correctly. It was raining, and very difficult to get pictures, but I did succeed in getting a good one of the old place.

We left with a kindly farewell, and went to the old church across the tracks in town. In the church we saw the old Bible dating from the seventeenth century. We found the pastor and he got down one of the old record books, and showed us the record referring to the birth and baptism of grandfather. The name was spelled in a variety of ways in the church records.

We are now nearing New York City, and our pleasant tour is almost ended.

(The following bits of information were gleaned from an old sheet of paper on which the late Frank Leimkuehler hastily scribbled a few notes for Dr. Myrtle Hinkhouse. This gives us the earliest possible information on the ancestral home and family, dating back to the twelfth century. We cannot vouch for the authenticity of all the statements, but they seem to agree in the main with various other records at hand.)

The Hinkhouse homestead is located at Hilter, Province of Hanover, Germany, near Osnabruck. The Hinghaus family located there in the year 1100, and this place has been in the possession of that family ever since. The church books were destroyed at the time of the Reformation, and many valuable records are gone around 1400 to 1500.

About 1565 [this date should be 1783, according to records at hand] only a daughter was left to inherit the homestead, and she was married to a man named Radenbrock. As was customary, he took the name of the homestead owner, or the name of his wife.

In about the year 1895 the heir to the homestead at that time came to America, and renounced his rights to the estate to his sister. She was married about the same year to August Meier-Dahausen, and he assumed the name Hinghaus, as was the custom of the country. They had one girl [Hilda, we have reason to believe], present heir to the estate (1938). In 1912 he erected a new, modern, commodious farmhouse close to the old one.

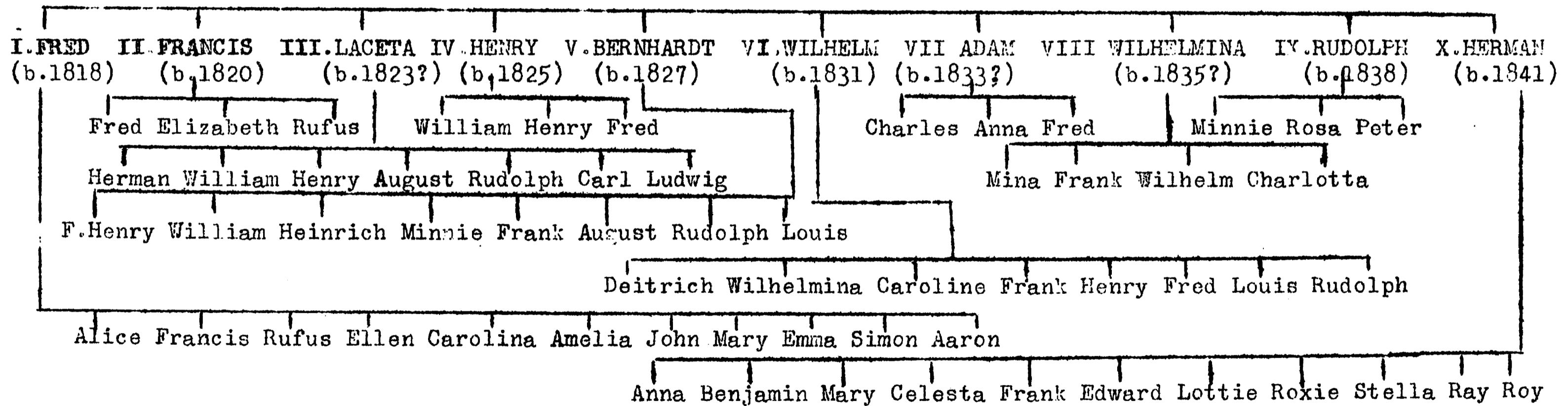

Dear Hinkhouse Relatives:

It has been over a year now since I sent out copies of the HINKHAUS Genealogy. Ever since then, off and on, I have been working on another branch, a little farther removed. This was incorporated in the Supplement of the first edition sent out, and now I have expanded it into a 3-page REVISED SUPPLEMENT, and numbered it pages 15, 16, and 17. (See explanatory note at top of page 15 for further details.)

Soon after the first edition was issued, it also seemed necessary, by request, to issue a revised sheet of page 4 of the "Origin, Name and Brief History," in order to include two other names under DISTINGUISHED MEMBERS OF THE FAMILY. So this page was also revised, and is now ready to send out.

Extra sheets of these four revised pages have been run off, and enclosed. In some cases, I am sending sets for closely related families who live in the same town, in the same envelope, to save postage, etc. Please see that a set of four sheets is passed out to each family named on the label.

Now a word as to inserting the new material in your genealogy. First, take out the two old sheets (page 4 of the History, and page 15, or the Supplement page that follows the genealogy proper). Tear these old sheets in two, and throw them in the wastebasket. (If you should get confused as to which are REVISED sheets, note that the word "REVISED" occurs at top of each of the four revised sheets.)

Next, insert the new sheets in their places, according to their page numbers. Then jog all the sheets together, and stick the two paper fasteners down through all the sheets, and clamp. You will notice that I have not punched holes in the new sheets, but it is not necessary if you will just follow directions. These directions may seem like going into too much detail to some, as they can probably arrange their copies without instructions. I am just giving them in case anyone might become confused.

I regret to say that space was not allowed at the top of the sheets for margin, because it was forgotten, but you can read all the essential information after assembling your genealogy. The binding at the top may cover up the page number.

One more word regarding the Revised Supplement, which brings in more names and addresses. Inasmuch as the GEOGRAPHICAL DIRECTORY in the back was made up before this Revised Supplement was worked out, the directory does not contain the location by States of these new names on the branch farther removed. The information came in too late for this. However the names and addresses are all there, in the Supplement; the great majority of them in Louisville, Kentucky.

In closing, I wish to thank you for the dozens of letters of appreciation received at the time I was working on the genealogy, and to renew my invitation for those who can to come to Washington to see me and the nation's capital.
